WPA members receive direct mailings of WPA newsletters, special bulletins, and conference announcements and get answers to their questions through Regional Coordinators and voice mail. They also save \$15 on conferences and \$7 on handbooks and receive other benefits.
- **Encourage people to plan now to attend WPA's 26th annual conference** in Oshkosh on May 1-2, 2009.
